The collection of books and manuscripts owned by the UI Library can be accessed by all levels of society without exception, with a total collection reaching 3.963.930 titles and 4.087.628 copies.

### Book Loan

- Maximum: 10 books
- Loan period: 28 days

- Late Fines: IDR 2,000 / book / day\*

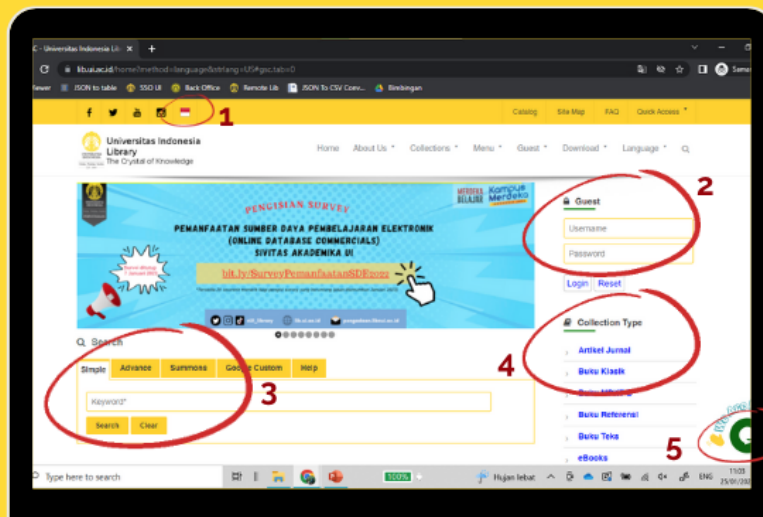

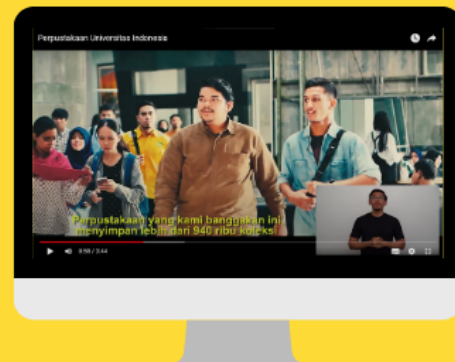


1. Click  for English language option
