6.5.3 Off-campus water conservation support

Support water conservation off campus.

Description

To support marine and coastal area conservation programs, students, the Student Executive Board (BEM), and the lecturers of Vocational Education Program of Universitas Indonesia, have held a community service program entitled GERTAKAU (Mangrove Planting Movement) or mangrove planting movement for the last three years. In 2022, this program was implemented on the beach in Eretan Kulon Village, Kandanghaur District, Indramayu Regency, West Java. Vokasi UI planted around 3,000 mangrove seedlings along the coastline. This activity was a continuation of the same program in the previous year, where Vocational UI planted around 2,000 mangrove seedlings. Through this program, it is hoped that mangrove plants can grow and become mangrove forests which can: become a good ecosystem on the coast; act as a filter so that rubbish flowing from the river is not directly thrown into the sea so that the seawater on the beach becomes cleaner; and can reduce shoreline erosion.
